Brass Audition Information

- 1) Please Download all files of the instrumental section you will be auditioning
- 2) Please bring your own instrument. You may audition with a French Horn, a Trombone, Concert Euphonium, Sousaphone or Concert Tuba if you choose, but marching instruments will work better for the visual portion of your audition. **TEAL SOUND INSTRUMENTS WILL NOT BE ASSIGNED TO ANYONE UNTIL AFTER THE FIRST ROUND OF AUDITIONS. EVERYONE, INCLUDING FORMER TEAL SOUND MEMBERS SHOULD BRING THEIR OWN INSTRUMENT FOR THE FIRST SECTION OF AUDITIONS**
- 3) Please Tune your instrument to A 442 - this will save time with the large amount of auditionees for this year's hornline
- 4) There are 3 components to your audition for the 2009 Teal Brass Section

Audition Piece #1 - Moving and Playing
Audition Piece #2 - Assigned Piece
Audition Piece #3 - Prepared (piece of your choosing)

Please prepare these three selections to the best of your ability. Piece #1 contains a marching and playing component that you should prepare BEFORE taking part in the auditions. #1 SHOULD ALSO BE MEMORIZED. Step-offs, halts, and direction changes are clearly marked on your music. All movement will be at 8 to 5 and 6 to 5 step sizes. Those auditioning should be prepared to perform #1 either alone or in groups of varying instrumentation during the audition weekend.
